The surgery was deemed a success Wednesday afternoon because the heart and kidneys survived the procedure well. Post-operatively, the sedation was continued because the team noticed unusual brain activity as well as seizures on the left side of the body. It was thought that the brain should be further sedated in order to minimize the effect of such activity. This approach worked, and we all waited as he was brought out of sedation. We knew it would take some time for the sedative to clear his bloodstream due to impaired kidney function, but the time has passed that he should have awakened. At this point we are praying for a miracle.

We also know that Dad's days were numbered by our God, and that perhaps He has answered our prayers that Dad not suffer a debilitating, protracted decline. The fact that he was certainly headed that way precipitated the decision to resort to surgery. We thank all of you for your prayers, your love, and your support. Pray for Dad and for Mom. She is having trouble making sense of it all, but knows that her dear Jimmie's life seems to be waning away.

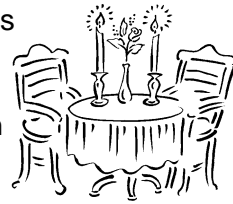
